TECHNICAL DETAILS

Le Musée du Champignon is located in Saumur (Saint-Hilaire-Saint-Florent), at 300 m from Pierre et Lumière and from 400 m of the Jardins du Puygirault.

ACCES

From the A11 direction Saumur A85.
On A85 exit N° 3 Saumur and on A87 exit N° 26 Saumur.
Then in Saumur, follow the direction of Gennes on the banks of the Loire.
The musée du Champignon is 1 km far from the exit of St-Hilaire-St-Florent.
